Driveway, Commercial, Private Road, or Subdivision Entrances

To process your application for a culvert permit, the following information is required to be submitted at the time of application. Applications cannot and will not be accepted electronically or by machine. Completed application and all associated information must be submitted to the City of Archie by the applicant/permit Holder. Commercial, private road, or subdivision permits will require application fee and inspection.

- 1. There will be an initial site inspection done by the City Official to determine culvert size, required location, and other safety.
- 2. The desired location of the proposed entrance must be marked on site.
- 3. Culverts shall be installed not more than 30 calendar days after the permit is issued, except during periods of adverse weather conditions.
- 4. Entrances shall be located to conform to the existing ditch line(s) or as directed by the City of Archie.
- 5. The City of Archie will NOT be responsible for the surfacing of driveways in conjunction with the culvert installation.
- 6. All entrances shall be constructed in such a manner as not to divert drainage to a roadway.
- 7. Culverts/Entrances installed not meeting the specifications and/or causing drainage problems may be removed as necessary to correct the drainage problem. The cost of new installations shall be borne entirely by the property owner. Commercial, private road, or subdivision permits will require bonding in addition to the required permit fee.
- 8. A Required Permit fee of \$200.00 (exact cash or check only) is due at the time of application. This fee is required and non-refundable.
- 9. An inspection by a City Employee or Official of the installation shall be requested and completed by the City of Archie before covering.
- 10. Culvert costs are paid entirely by the property owner. The Applicant/Permit holder's responsibility is to purchase and maintain the application. Applicants will also need to ensure the ditch lines and culvert location are free of debris, toys, decorations, and roadway reflectors for the entire distance of the property. The City of Archie installation crews will not be responsible for damage to any personal items left in the work zone. Installation crews will be responsible for removing and hauling away old culvert and installing of new culvert. Placing 1" base rock over the new culvert and performing necessary ditching within the work zone.
